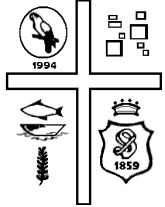
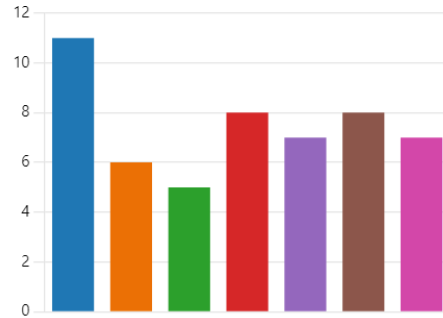

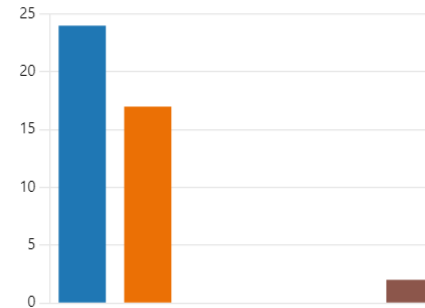

My child is happy at this school



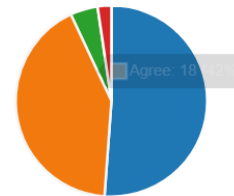

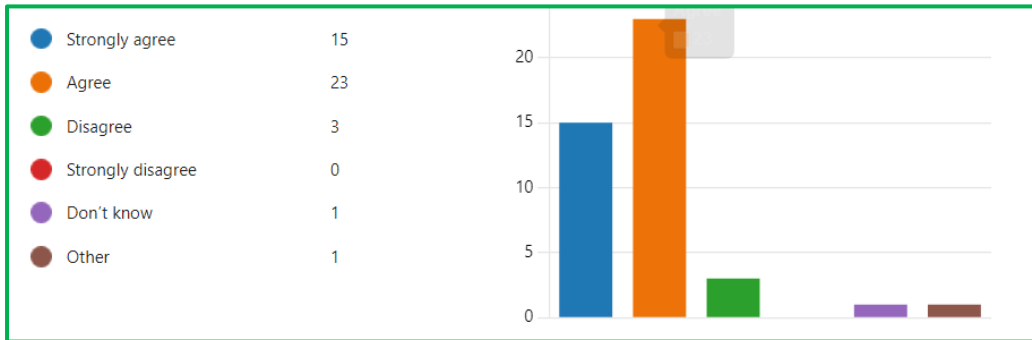

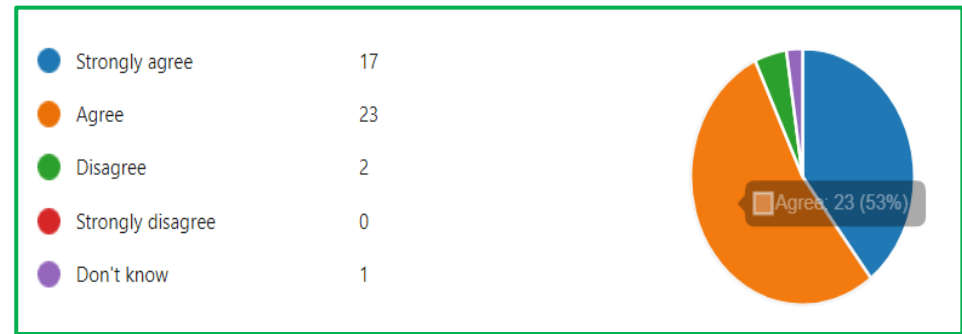
My child does not have SEND 60%

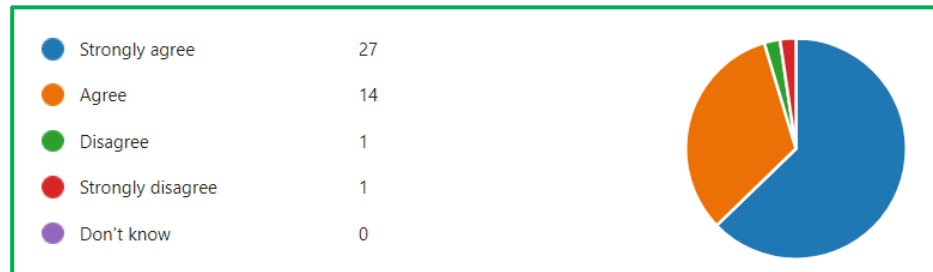
The school has high expectations for my child



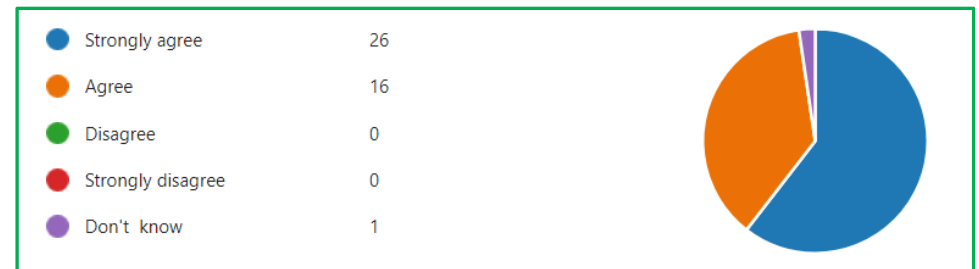
My child does well at this school



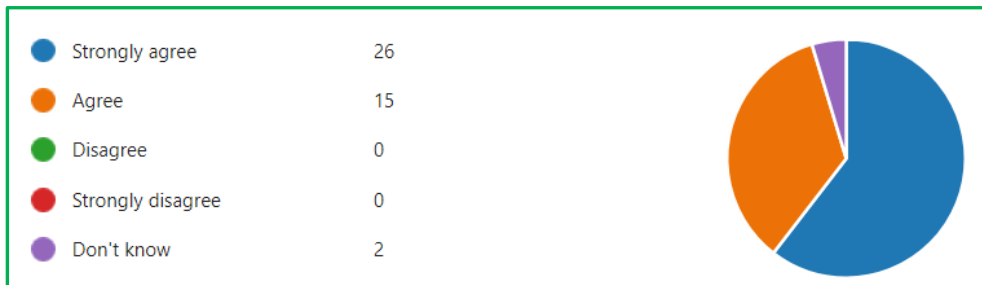
The school lets me know how my child is doing



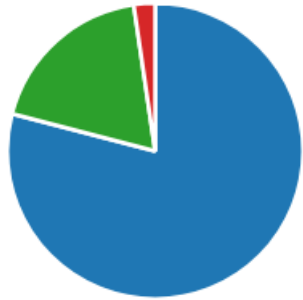
There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.



My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school

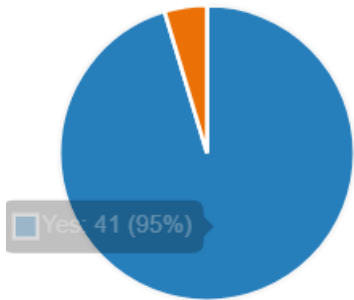


The school supports my child's wider professional development (Wellbeing, PHSE Diversity)

'My main feedback would be to push children that have the ability to go further. I feel that my child would excel more if they was challenged to do so

Having a secure online platform where the school can enter results from test scores would be very helpful, such as maths tests and the weekly spelling tests, or anything building up to the timetable test in Y4 and Y6 SATs.

Make parents evening a positive experience.

More excursions/incursions for variety

To keep doing what they are doing and keep moving towards a more restorative justice approach.

Inter pupil distractions don't seem to be adequately managed I would like to see some of the fun elements return. For example, the Christmas theatre trip and more school trips in general

School grounds- they need updating

To raise funds for the school, there's an app called Easy Fundraising - free to install. You could add Curzon as a 'cause' and encourage parents to download the app and choose Curzon as their cause. It's all completely free - you open the app, click on the store you want to online shop with (Amazon, John Lewis, Currys, Boots, Morrisons, Waitrose, booking.com etc) the app takes you to the store and when you make a purchase the retailer donates to the cause at no cost the person or cause.

More Clubs at lunch run by teachers

My child is on a support plan and whilst I think that there is good support for his progress, more regular updates and a clearer set of support actions that I can expect would help me to know exactly what additional support he is being given.

Parents events to explain what is happening. Know I am doing the right thing

More clubs. Would love to see an eco team to promote sustainability. Would love to see an Amdram society for a school production

More communication of what is expected of parents with regards to home learning. When to read / write/ learn numbers etc most schools within the area had a meeting within the first couple of weeks of term to explain what was needed from us as parents. Aware of we have a phonics evening soon but I believe this needs to be earlier.

Class dojo is quite cumbersome to manage and navigate - maybe some CPD for parents so they are able to use the app correctly. If it is the main communication portal for the school I would definitely consider trying to find out if parents know how to use it - especially EYFS as we are new to it

An after school provision as I work until six and would like school to offer that for me and my child. Makes life easier.

Clubs run by teachers

Would be great if each class has a pet animal children could take turn to look after and share responsibilities in the weekend. This will encourage sharing, emotional development and empathy, amongst other things!

Keep doing what you are doing!

Overall I feel the provision is very good at the school Stretch/challenge/give it a go tasks on homework As parents we would like to know which spellings are incorrect so they can be revisited at home.

Don't like the cost of school dinners- why did they increase?

The traffic situation is getting worse. The new parking bollards are being ignored and the extra children have increased the cars around school. The bollards need to be placed out on the zigzags. Children eating packed lunches continue to complain of being rushed and bring home half eaten food. This has been an ongoing theme for many years.
